## November 9, 2010 Minutes Washington County Board of Supervisors Supervisor's Room Courthouse Blair, Nebraska 68008

The Washington County Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska, met in regular session at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, November 9, 2010 in the Supervisor's Meeting Room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the Office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgment of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman, Duane Wilcox declared the meeting was in session and that the meeting was being recorded. Chairman made note that the Open Meetings Law was posted on the door and the north wall. Present: Chairman, Duane Wilcox, County Board Members, Linda Thomsen, Kent Clausen, Jeff Quist, Mary Alice Johnson, Ernest Abariotes and Ron Hineline. Also present, Deputy County Clerk Robin Miller and Deputy County Attorney Ed Talbot.

It was moved by Abariotes and seconded by Clausen that the rules be suspended and that the minutes of the October 26, 2010 meeting be approved with the following corrections: minutes referred to the October 14 Board meeting- it should say October 12<sup>th</sup>, and also on the Planning Administrators items, the Lot Split and Rezoning for Robert L. MacDonald Trust needed a record of the Board's vote, which was all 7 members voting aye. Minutes were not read at this meeting for the reason that all Board Members were furnished a copy of said minutes prior to the meeting. Vote- Aye: Thomsen, Clausen, Quist, Wilcox, Johnson, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. Hineline mentioned that some items on the agenda say discussion and some don't. He feels it should not say discussion on the agenda, that all items will be discussed.

It was moved by Hineline and seconded by Abariotes that the regular Monthly Fee Reports of the following Officials be received and placed on file: Co Clerk \$371.24, Reg of Deeds \$19,868.00, Co Court \$20,914.43, Co Plan Dept \$6,630.00, Clk Dist Crt \$1,776.17, Sheriff \$3,279.77, Road Dept \$26,311.24 and Weed Dept \$440.88. Vote- Aye: Thomsen, Clausen, Quist, Wilcox, Johnson, Hineline and Abariotes. Nay: None. Motion carried. There was no correspondence at this time.

Steve Eppley with Western Engineering discussed the proposal for County Road P30, quarry road. He stated time is really short and they need to get the work done by next week if the Board wants to proceed. Deputy Co Attorney Talbot noted Board had previously decided this would fall outside the normal bidding requirements based upon the free labor and materials that are saving the county money. Motion was made by Quist and second by Clausen to do the following items from the proposal: #3- Skin Patch \$9,250.00; #4- Install 4" Depth 3" Crusher Run Aggregate, Incorporate 8" Depth, Compact and Reshape \$25,600.80 and #5- Traffic Control \$1,500.00 for a total of \$36,350.80. Vote- Aye: Thomsen, Clausen, Quist, Wilcox, Johnson. Nays: Abariotes. Hineline abstained. Motion carried.

Quist stated the motorgrader bids were discussed at the Road Committee meeting. Mike Sweetman, Murphy Tractor was present. Motion by Hineline second by Abariotes to accept the recommendation of the Road Committee and award the bid to Murphy Tractor & Equipment Co for a John Deere 772 G (Six Wheel Drive) motor grader for \$197,300. Vote-Aye: Thomsen, Clausen, Quist, Johnson, Hineline and Abariotes. Nay: Wilcox. Motion carried.

Doug Cook, Planning Admin. was present to ask the Board if they want him to advertise for 3 Planning Commission members whose terms expire at the end of the year. It was moved by Quist and second by

Thomsen to advertise for Planning Commission Members. Vote-Aye: Thomsen, Clausen, Quist, Wilcox, Johnson and Abariotes. Nays: Hineline. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Quist, second by Clausen to designate the Enterprise and Pilot Tribune as the Official Newspapers for County Publications for 2011. Vote- Aye: Thomsen, Clausen, Quist, Wilcox, Johnson, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Deputy County Clerk read a letter from Washington County Treasurer, Marj Hoier, which stated 144 Distress Warrants in the amount of \$169,923.44 were turned over to the Sheriff's Department for collection on November 1, 2010. Motion by Quist, second by Clausen to receive the letter and place on file. Vote- Aye: Thomsen, Clausen, Quist, Wilcox, Johnson, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Quist, second by Clausen to adopt Resolution 2010-45, transferring money from the Inheritance Tax Fund to General Fund and Building Fund. Vote- Aye: Thomsen, Clausen, Quist, Wilcox, Johnson, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.
