Resolution 2011- 44 Board of Equalization Washington County, Nebraska Resolution Setting 2011-2012 Levy of Taxes

WHEREAS, by virtue of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 77-1601 (2003 Supp), the Board is required by law to levy the taxes necessary for all political subdivisions within the County; and,
