The Washington County Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska, met in regular session at 8:37 a.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 11, 2012 in the Supervisor's Meeting Room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgment of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman Mary Alice Johnson declared the meeting was in session and that the meeting is being recorded. Johnson made note that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the door and the north wall. Present: Chairman, Mary Alice Johnson, County Board Members, Kent Clausen, Jerry Kruse, Jeff Quist, Steve Kruger, Ernest Abariotes and Ron Hineline. Also present, County Clerk Merry Truhlsen and Deputy County Attorney Ed Talbot.

Motion Kruger, second Kruse to approve agenda for December 11th, 2012. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. It was moved by Hineline and seconded by Abariotes that the rules be suspended and that the minutes of the November 27, 2012 meeting be approved but not read at this meeting for the reason that all board members were furnished a copy of said minutes prior to the meeting. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Abariotes and Hineline. Kruger abstained. Nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Hineline and seconded by Kruger that the regular monthly fee reports of the following officials be received and placed on file: Co Clerk \$249.50, Reg of Deeds \$25,031.25, Co Court \$16,752.01, Co Plan Dept \$4,246, Clk Dist Crt \$1082.75, Sheriff \$2,667.75 and Road Dept \$235,791.78. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

The following correspondence has been received: State Dept of Revenue Lodging tax for November is \$1,182.78 and a letter from the Fort Calhoun Fire and Rescue Department. It was moved by Kruse and seconded by Clausen that the correspondence be received and placed on file. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Cheryl Parsons, Hwy Supt. and Kruger had met with landowner Todd Schmidt, who has concerns about the Marshall-Nursery Road Project C89(531). Schmidt said after looking at the plans and seeing the tube will be raised 5 feet, he is concerned about water backing up on his property. Schmidt also doesn't feel the tube at the end of his driveway needs to be replaced. Board discussed the project. Parsons said she, Kruger, Quist and Julie Ogden, engineer would meet on site with Schmidt and go over the plans before any action on the project is taken.

Parsons said bridge replacement project, Bridge No. C89-22605P Fort Calhoun Northwest, was discussed at the Road Committee meeting. Board talked about getting the proposals before making a final decision on this project. Motion Hineline second Kruse to continue with the engineering in preparation to let bids on the project. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Kim Gatrost, Executive Assistant, Lake Arrowhead Inc, had previously met with the Board and discussed the possibility of installing a new turning lane at Lake Arrowhead (Lakeland Estates). As there is no funding for this sort of improvement at the present time, Parsons talked to Gatrost about improving the shoulders of the road for cars waiting for the gate to open. Quist asked Parsons to check with NIRMA on safety issues involved. Motion Clausen, second Kruse to have County forces stabilize the shoulders by widening, putting millings on and using super patch if necessary, with the subdivision agreeing to pay up to \$1000 for materials used and pending NIRMA's approval. Vote-Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Motion Kruse second Clausen to authorize Chairman to sign the annual Nebraska Department of Roads Certification of County Highway Superintendent form for determining incentive payment for the period of January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Tanna Wirtz, Planning Administrator, said she had received applications from 4 people interested in serving on the Planning Commission. Two current Board members, Wes Petznick and Matt Mathiesen's terms had expired. Motion Kruger second

Abariotes to put the following applicants on the ballot: Tammy Hughbanks, Chris Bilau, Wes Petnick and Matt Mathiesen. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. Board voted by secret ballot. Clerk tallied the votes: Petznick-6, Mathiesen-5, Hughbanks-2, Bilau-1. Motion Kruger second Kruse to appoint Wes Petznick and Matt Mathiesen to serve 3 year terms on the Planning Commission. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Capt. Rob Bellamy wanted to make the Board aware that Prochaska & Associates have finished the Jail Needs Assessment. They would like time at the next Board meeting to give the Board a tour of the jail then go over their presentation. Board discussed the project.

The courthouse is scheduled to close at noon on Christmas Eve, but Clerk discussed the possibility of Federal and State offices closing all day on Christmas Eve and asked if that happens if the Courthouse could also close all day. Motion Hineline second Abariotes to keep the Courthouse open Christmas Eve until noon. Vote- Aye: Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: Clausen and Kruse. Motion carried.

Board received a letter from Rebecca Versch, Extension Educator, about appointing members to the Washington County Extension Board. The Extension Board's recommendation is to reappoint Don Helms and Randy Jensen and appoint Annette Ott and James Brown, to replace Linda Rogge and Todd Schlueter whose terms have expired. Motion Kruger second Kruse to accept the recommendation of the Washington County Extension Board: re-appoint Helms and Jensen and appoint Ott and Brown. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

At 9:30 AM motion was made by Kruse and seconded by Clausen to enter into closed session. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. Chairman stated the reason for the closed session was in order to protect the public interest with respect to Sheriff's Office FOP labor negotiations and litigation. At 10:01 AM, motion by Kruger and second by Kruse to end closed session. Vote- Aye: Clausen, Kruse, Quist, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. Chairman again stated the reason for the closed session was in order to protect the public interest with respect to Sheriff's Office FOP labor negotiations. No action was in order to protect the public interest with respect to Sheriff's Office FOP labor negotiation. No action was taken.

There were no comments from the public.

Claims were received and reviewed, following which it was moved by Kruger and seconded by Kruse that the following claims be allowed and Clerk ordered to issue warrants on the various funds for the same.
