The Washington County Board of Equalization of Washington County, Nebraska, met in regular session at 8:30 A.M. on Tuesday, Oct 8, 2013 in the Supervisor's Meeting Room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgment of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman made note that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the door and the north wall. Present: Chairman Jeff Quist, County Board Members: Paul Cerio, Jerry Kruse, Mary Alice Johnson, Steven Kruger, Ernest Abariotes and Ron Hinline. Also present, County Clerk Merry Truhlsen, County Assessor Steven Mencke and Jean Ray, Deputy.

Motion by Kruse and second by Johnson that the rules be suspended and that the minutes of the Sept 24th meeting be approved but not read at this meeting for the reason that all Board Members were furnished a copy of said minutes prior to the meeting. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Abariotes and Hinline. Kruger abstained. Nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Abariotes and seconded by Hinline to approve Valuation Changes for 10-8-2013 as presented by the Assessor. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hinline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Abariotes and seconded by Hinline to approve Correction #6671 through 6672 as presented by the Assessor. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hinline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Motion Kruger second Johnson to adopt Resolution 2013- 29 setting final tax levies for 2013-2014. Cerio, Hinline and Pam Daly discussed postponing setting tax levies. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Abariotes and Kruger. Nay: Cerio and Hinline. Motion carried.

Resolution Setting 2013-2014 Levy of Taxes**

WHEREAS, by virtue of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 77-1601 (2003 Supp), the Board is required by law to levy the taxes necessary for all political subdivisions within the County; and,

WHEREAS, levies have been certified to the Washington County Clerk by those entities required to do so by Neb. Rev. Stat. 13-508(2) (2004 Cumulative Supp), as shown on the attached Exhibit "A."

WHEREAS, it has been represented to the Washington County Clerk that all special hearing, publication and notice requirements have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION the taxes for the current year, 2013-2014 are hereby levied at the rate set for the various political subdivisions as shown on the attached Exhibit "A."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board's Clerk provide a certified copy of this resolution to the Washington County Assessor for proper transcribing of such levy of taxation to the Tax Commissioner.
