The Washington County Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska, met in regular session at 8:35 a.m. on Tuesday, March 11, 2014 in the Supervisor's Meeting Room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgment of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman Jeff Quist declared the meeting was in session and that the meeting is being recorded. Quist made note that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the door and the north wall. Present: Chairman, Jeff Quist, County Board Members, Paul Cerio, Jerry Kruse, Mary Alice Johnson, Steve Kruger, Ernest Abariotes and Ron Hineline. Also present, County Clerk Merry Truhlsen Motion Kruger second Johnson to approve agenda for March 11th, 2014, with the item on holding a running race in the County pulled as per phone call from Maria Bledsoe. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. It was moved by Kruger and seconded by Hineline that the rules be suspended and that the minutes of the February 25, 2014 meeting be approved but not read at this meeting for the reason that all board members were furnished a copy of said minutes prior to the meeting. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Hineline and seconded by Abariotes that the regular monthly fee reports of the following officials be received and placed on file: Co Clerk \$351.84, Reg of Deeds \$14,562.75, Co Court \$18,642.75, Co Plan Dept \$3,002.00, Clk Dist Crt \$1,397.75, Sheriff \$2,576.40 and Road Dept \$3,102. Feb Treas Statement- Collections 604,652.93; Disbursements 820,275.01; Inheritance Tax 1,870,451.76; Ending balance 8,007,980.63. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

The following correspondence has been received: copy of letters sent to Michael Kirby and Robert Smith from the Planning and Zoning Dept. It was moved by Kruger and seconded by Abariotes that the correspondence be received and placed on file. Vote-Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Cheryl Parsons, Hwy Supt., had the following items;

Dan Norman, Civil Solutions, said a meeting to discuss the plans for CR P43 was well attended. Norman reviewed 3 options previously discussed for the road. Board discussed the plans. Motion Kruger second Hineline to continue discussion with Township 1, City of Fort Calhoun and landowners and to agree to share costs for a T intersection on County Road P43 and Lincoln Street with Township 1 and City of Ft Calhoun. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: Kruse. Motion carried.

Parsons discussed new requirements by the State to check road signage. Parsons proposed purchasing a reflectometer, at a cost of approximately \$10,000, and share the cost/ownership with City of Blair and Burt County. Al Schoemaker, Director of Public Works for City of Blair spoke. Board discussed the proposal. Motion Kruger second Kruse to propose entering into a cost share agreement with Burt County and the City of Blair to purchase a reflectometer, with an inter-local agreement to be drawn up and details of purchase to be further discussed. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Finance Committee Chairman Kruger said according to the Budget Timeline approved in February, at the first meeting in March the Budget Making Authority should be voted on and discussion on capital improvement projects started. Motion Kruger to renew contract with Merry Truhlsen to be the Budget Making Authority, for \$3,000, which only means Truhlsen puts the numbers in that the Board presents her with, second by Kruse. Dennis McCormick and Sarah Bryan spoke. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Quist and Kruger. Nay: Cerio, Johnson, Abariotes and Hineline. Motion did not pass. Kruger asked Board members to let him or Chairman Quist know what capital improvement projects they would like to see in the 2014-2015 Budget. Board discussed several projects. Sheriff Mike Robinson spoke.

Clerk had received an email from Lydia Brash thanking Board for sending a letter of support for LB881, Law Enforcement Motor Vehicle Pursuit Legislation. Dennis McCormick and Robinson spoke. There was no other discussion of bills.

Clerk said a request from Blair City to use the north Courthouse lawn for Gateway to West Days, June 7, was received, along with their certificate of insurance. Motion Hineline second Abariotes to approve the request to use the north Courthouse lawn for the Gateway to the West days, subject to County Attorney's review. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Clerk reported County Treasurer Marj Hoier held the 2014 Tax Sale on March 3. There were 44 bidders, 99 tax sales were purchased and the total amount paid was \$234,197.02. Motion Hineline second Abariotes to accept the 2014 Tax Sale Report and place on file. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Committee reports: Hineline and Cerio had talked to Surveyors' office on upcoming changes and the need to involve the next Surveyor in decisions regarding the office.

Comments from public: Scott Vander Schaaf spoke.
