April 8, 2014 Minutes Washington County Board of Supervisors Supervisor's Room Courthouse Blair, Nebraska 68008

The Washington County Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska, met in regular session at 8:55 a.m. on Tuesday, April 8, 2014 in the Supervisor's Meeting Room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgment of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman Jeff Quist declared the meeting was in session and that the meeting is being recorded. Quist made note that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the door and the north wall. Present: Chairman, Jeff Quist, County Board Members, Jerry Kruse, Mary Alice Johnson, Steve Kruger, Ernest Abariotes and Ron Hineline. Paul Cerio was absent. Also present, County Clerk Merry Truhlsen.

Motion Abariotes second Kruse to approve agenda for April 8th, 2014. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. Chairman asked for approval of the minutes of the March 25 meeting. Abariotes asked that "try" be taken out of his motion for the GOATZ run. Dennis McCormick objected to the minutes based on Statute 84-1411. It was moved by Hineline and seconded by Abariotes to table approving the 3/25 minutes until Statute could be checked. Vote-Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Hineline and seconded by Abariotes that the regular monthly fee reports of the following officials be received and placed on file: Co Clerk \$537.53, Reg of Deeds \$24,312.50, Co Court \$19,298.78, Co Plan Dept \$10,262.00, Clk Dist Crt \$955.55, Sheriff \$2,908.32 and Road Dept \$34,810. March Treasurer Statement- Collections 833,428.40; Disbursements 783,089.56; Inheritance Tax 1,899,490.78; Ending balance 8,058,319.47. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

The following correspondence had been received: NRD is having a scrap computer/electronics collection, letter from Dennis Vodicka asking to be recognized as a Structural Bridge Engineer and letter from Wes Ehlers, Sequoia Consulting Group about indirect cost rates. It was moved by Kruger and seconded by Kruse that the correspondence be received and placed on file. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Cheryl Parsons, Hwy Supt., received two bids for approximately five miles of microsurfacing: Sta-Bilt Construction Co-\$198,284 and Monarch Oil Co - \$198,828. Board discussed bids, Dan Norman spoke. Motion Kruse second Johnson to accept the low bid of \$198,284 from Sta-Bilt Const Co subject to Parsons verifying numbers. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger and Hineline. Nay: Abariotes. Motion carried.

Parsons received one bid for approximately 10 miles of armor coat: Sta-Bilt Construction Co - \$194,305.52. Parsons discussed the armor coating to be done with the Board. Motion Kruger second Abariotes to accept Sta-Bilt Construction Co bid of \$194,305.52 subject to Parsons verifying numbers. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. Later in the meeting Parsons reported she verified the figures on both bids and they were accurate.

Dan Norman, Civil Solutions, said he did a site visit on County Rd P43. Norman said Township 1 has removed some trees and he suggested putting a silt fence in. Norman discussed the project and said he looked at the cost estimates again and it is still in the \$300,000 range. Norman asked for more information for the driveway permits for the school. Joy Ruma, Zoning Administrator for Ft Calhoun, said she could have school's architect contact Norman with the information needed.

Sean Johnson, Executive Director, Gateway Development Corp, gave a quarterly update on projects in Washington County.

In accordance with Statute 23-1608, the County Board hired the CPA firm of Ritterbush & Piotrowski to perform a complete and comprehensive annual audit of the books, accounts and records of all County Officers. An original copy of the audit report through June 30, 2013 is on file with the Washington County Clerk. Motion Kruger second Kruse to receive and place on file the Washington County audit from Ritterbusch & Piotrowski through June 30, 2013. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. William Burdess spoke.

Motion Kruger second Abariotes to table the Finance Committee budget timeline and budget making authority agenda item until April 22. Vote-Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

County Attorney Graeve submitted a two year Child Support contract with Steven Kraviec for the Board's approval. Motion Hineline second Johnson to approve the Child Support Agreement with Steven J. Kraviec for \$36,000 in attorney fees and \$4,000 for mailing costs and Sheriff fees per year, for August 1, 2014 through July 31, 2016. Vote-Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Kruger said the Technology Committee met and discussed committee members. Chairman Quist said he appointed Dan Douglas, Arlington Fire Department, to serve on the Technology Oversight Committee.

The following committees gave updates: Technology Committee, Building & Grounds, Jail Committee and Personnel Committee. Sheriff Robinson and Dennis McCormick spoke.

Quist discussed approving 3/25 minutes. McCormick and Stamp spoke. Motion by Hineline second Abariotes to table approving minutes until the next meeting. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Comments from public: Wes Stamp, Dennis McCormick and William Burdess spoke.

Claims were received and reviewed, following which it was moved by Kruger and seconded by Johnson that the following claims be allowed and Clerk ordered to issue warrants on the various funds for the same. Vote-Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.
