The Washington County Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska, met in special session at 8:35 a.m. on Friday, May 16, 2014 in the Supervisor's Meeting Room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance as per Neb Rev Statutes 23-154, "by posting up notices in three public places in the county". This Notice of the meeting was posted in the Arlington, Blair, Ft Calhoun, Herman and Kennard Post Offices on Monday, May 12. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman Jeff Quist declared the meeting was in session and that the meeting is being recorded. Quist made note that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the door and the north wall. Present: Chairman, Jeff Quist, County Board Members, Paul Cerio, Jerry Kruse, Mary Alice Johnson, Steve Kruger, Ernest Abariotes and Ron Hinline. Also present, County Clerk Merry Truhlsen Motion Kruger second Abariotes to approve agenda for May 16th, 2014. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hinline. Nay: None. Motion carried. It was moved by Kruger and seconded by Abariotes that the rules be suspended and that the minutes of the April 22, 2014 meeting be approved but not read at this meeting for the reason that all board members were furnished a copy of said minutes prior to the meeting. Cerio discussed the newspaper minutes. Vote- Aye: Kruse, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hinline. Nay: Cerio. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION NO. 2014 - 7

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A
"COALITION FOR THE PRESERVATION OF FORT ATKINSON"

Whereas a site on the bluff above the Missouri River, on the east edge of what is now the City of Fort Calhoun, Nebraska, has been documented and indelibly etched in history as the site of Captain Meriwether Lewis' and Captain William Clark's first council with Native American Indians on Friday, August 3, 1804 as the Corps of Discovery journeyed into the western territory acquired through the Louisiana Purchase of 1803;

Whereas, based on the recommendation of Lewis and Clark, that bluff became the site of Fort Atkinson, which was constructed and occupied from 1819 to 1827 – the first American military outpost west of the Missouri River -- which site and Fort became a key launching point for development of the westerly portion of the United States of America;

Whereas Fort Atkinson is a geographic landmark and an enduring reference point in the lore and history of the United States of America, the State of Nebraska, Washington County, and the City of Fort Calhoun, Nebraska, which through efforts of the Nebraska State Historical Society, area civic leaders and the State of Nebraska was surveyed, acquired and reconstructed duplicating the original Fort on the original foundations or locations of the Fort's facilities; and

Whereas changing spending priorities and competition for State appropriations now threaten the continued existence of Fort Atkinson;

Now therefore be it resolved that it is desirable and in the best interests of this Nation, the State of Nebraska, the County of Washington, the City of Fort Calhoun, and the Washington County Historical Association to form an alliance with the Fort Atkinson Foundation and with the Friends of Fort Atkinson volunteers as a "Coalition for the Preservation of Fort Atkinson" to cooperatively provide a means to continue the recognition of Fort Atkinson in western development and to pay tribute to Lewis and Clark and the military and civilians who staffed the Fort; and

Be it further resolved that by this resolution, the County of Washington, in the State of Nebraska, hereby states its intent to preserve the Fort through a "Coalition for the Preservation of Fort Atkinson" to work in cooperation with the State of Nebraska, the Game and Parks Commission, the Washington County Historical Association, Washington County, the City of Fort Calhoun, The Fort Atkinson Foundation, the Friends of Fort Atkinson volunteers and others to preserve Fort Atkinson for future generations communicating and preserving values which define the United States of America and its enduring pioneering spirit.
