The Washington County Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska, met in regular session at 8:43 a.m. on Tuesday, August 12, 2014 in the Supervisor's Meeting Room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgment of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman Jeff Quist declared the meeting was in session and that the meeting is being recorded. Quist made note that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the door and the north wall. Present: Chairman, Jeff Quist, County Board Members, Paul Cerio, Mary Alice Johnson, Steve Kruger, Ernest Abariotes and Ron Hineline. Jerry Kruse was absent. Also present, County Clerk Merry Truhlsen.

Motion Kruger second Johnson to approve agenda for August 12th, 2014. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. It was moved by Abariotes and seconded by Kruger that the rules be suspended and that the minutes of the July 15, 2014 and July 22nd meeting be approved but not read at this meeting for the reason that all board members were furnished a copy of said minutes prior to the meeting. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Kruger and seconded by Johnson that the correspondence be received and placed on file. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Cheryl Parsons, Hwy Supt, Road Dept items: Parsons discussed purchasing new equipment. Motion Johnson second Kruger to direct Hwy Supt. to go out for bids on a new dump truck, plow and sander and a new pickup. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Parsons gave an brief update on Road Projects. Parsons read a resolution regarding the bid let on Federal Aid Project BRO-7089(23) Blair West, box culvert. Motion Kruger second Johnson to adopt Resolution 2014-19. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Grading, Culvert, General Items: \$786,373.20

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above facts, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Washington, by this resolution, takes the following official action:

1. If for any reason the Federal Highway Administration rescinds, limits its obligations, or defers payment of the Federal share of the cost of this project, the County hereby agrees to provide the necessary

funds to pay for all costs incurred until and in the event such Federal funds are allowed and paid.

2. The Board hereby concurs in the selection of the above mentioned contractor(s) for the items of work listed, to whom the contract(s) should be awarded.

3. The Board hereby authorizes the Chairman to sign the contract(s) with the above mentioned Contractor(s) for the above mentioned work on behalf of the County.

Eric Obert, JEO Consulting Group, went over a handout showing the estimated cost for the Marshall Nursery Project, box culvert on Co Rd 38. Board discussed having coring done before making a decision on the project.

Obert discussed the rehab of Bridge C89-05105P, in Boyer Chute area. Since the bridge is closed and is a bus route, Obert asked the Board if they wanted to go through the normal bidding process, which would take a while, or he recommended declaring this an emergency and go to a contractor of choice to get started. Board discussed the bridge rehab, which Obert estimates will cost between \$80,000 to \$100,000. Motion Cerio second Hineline to concur with Obert's recommendation to declare this bridge an emergency repair. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: Quist. Motion carried.

Obert next discussed Bridge C89-22605P, Ft Calhoun Northwest and said he will have something on this in a few weeks.

Obert went through Change Order #1 on the Ft Calhoun West paving project. The change order was an increase of \$25,483.64 and brought the project total to date at \$613,562.67. Motion Kruger second Hineline to approve paying the change order of \$25,483.64. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Motion Cerio second Hineline to have an evening meeting on August 21, 7:00 PM for general information on the budget. Vote-Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Quist and Kruger abstained, they won't be able to attend the meeting. Motion carried. Board discussed the meeting. Stamp spoke. Motion Cerio second Hineline to reconsider the motion to change the date of the evening meeting. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried. Motion Cerio second Hineline to have a meeting on August 19, 7:00 PM in multipurpose room for 2014-2015 budget information. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Ric Ortmeier, Budget Consultant, explained the resolution to allow the County's budget authority to increase by 1% and recommended the Board adopt the resolution. Board discussed this. Wes Stamp spoke. Clerk read resolution. Motion Kruger second Johnson to adopt Resolution 2014-20. Vote- Aye: Johnson, Quist, Kruger and Abariotes. Nay: Cerio and Hineline. Motion did not carry with the 75% vote as required.

Ron Hineline spoke about the 1&6 Year Plan and dedicating money for fund without identifying projects. Board discussed this and the money in the Hard Surface Fund. William Burdess and Trevor Kruger spoke.

Julie Ashton, Director, Wash Co Historical Association, said the Game & Parks Commission has approached the WCHA with the desire to partner with them to help maintain the operation of Ft Atkinson State Historical Park. Ashton discussed this and the levy for the WCHA with the Board. Several WCHA Board members were present, Michael O'Brien spoke. Lisa Kramer and Pam Daly spoke. Johnson moved to table this for clarification, then rescinded her motion. Board asked Ashton to provide information regarding the WCHA.

Motion Kruger second Johnson to adopt Resolution 2014-18 approving the application for a Special Designated Liquor License for Rises's Drive-In Liquor. Vote- Aye: Cerio, Johnson, Quist, Kruger, Abariotes and Hineline. Nay: None. Motion carried.
