Board of Equalization Washington County, Nebraska Resolution Setting 2017-2018 Levy of Taxes

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board's Clerk provide a certified copy of this resolution to the Washington County Assessor for proper transcribing of such levy of taxation to the Tax Commissioner.
