September 11, 2018 Minutes Washington County Board of Supervisors Supervisor's Room Courthouse Blair, Nebraska 68008

The Washington County Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska, met in regular session at 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 11, 2018 in the Supervisor's meeting room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgment of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman Steve Dethlefs declared the meeting was in session and that the meeting is being recorded. Dethlefs made note that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the door and the west wall. Present: Chairman, Steve Dethlefs, County Board Members, Carl Lorenzen, Lisa Kramer, Bob Frahm, Andy Andreasen, Steven Kruger and Jay Anderson. Also present County Clerk Designee Barb Sullivan and Co Atty Scott VanderSchaaf.

Mike Robinson, Sheriff, requested an emergency item be placed on the agenda involving school resource officers. Motion by Kruger seconded by Andreasen to place emergency item regarding school resource officers on agenda. Vote- Aye: Lorenzen, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Motion Kruger second Andreasen to approve agenda for September 11, 2018. Vote:-Aye: Lorenzen, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried. It was moved by Frahm and seconded by Kruger that the rules be suspended and that the minutes of the August 28, 2018 meeting be approved but not read at this meeting for the reason that all board members were furnished a copy of said minutes prior to the meeting. Vote-Aye: Lorenzen, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Kruger and seconded by Kramer that the regular monthly fee reports of the following officials be received and placed on file: Co Clerk \$423; Reg of Deeds \$35,180; Co Court \$21,739; Co Plan Dept \$18,835; Clk Dist Crt \$3,711; Sheriff \$1,580; and Road Dept \$3,786; July Treas Statement- Collections \$3,768,715; Disbursements \$1,919,066; Inheritance Tax \$1,316,207, Ending balance \$8,067,683. Vote- Aye: Lorenzen, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried. There was no correspondence.

Bill Hansel, Hwy Supt, gave a brief update of road projects. Hansel said the Blair Bottom Rd bridge can be seeded this week. Also, bridge on Co Rd 40 has the west piling drove and will pour the piling cap on it sometime this week. Hansel stated that Co Rd 34 reconstruction is still under water and currently has pumps running. Extension has been granted to November 1. Hansel congratulated Road Dept employee Justin Mantz for placing 5th and 7th, respectively, for skid loader and backhoe events at a national competition held in Kansas City. Hansel also discussed trading in current mower with a smaller mower since mower used now is too large and it blows excess grass on roads creating issues.

Public comments: Kenneth Hansen discussed concerns over dumpsters located on right of way on Co Rd P27. Bill Hansel provided State Statute information as it pertains to the dumpster removal process.

Dan Douglas, Emergency Manager, gave an update on the Emergency Manager Office. Douglas stated that phone and email have been set up and office is operational. Board members discussed future available office space and vehicle for said office.

Ron Hineline was not present for an agenda item discussing zoning on his property, known as Tax Lot 76. VanderSchaaf suggested this be tabled. It will be on a Planning and Zoning item. Motion by Kruger and seconded by Anderson to table this agenda item till next Board meeting. Vote- Aye: Lorenzen, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Mike Robinson, Sheriff, discussed adding a full time resource officer at Ft Calhoun and Arlington School Districts. Robinson provided Board with a copy of the School Resource Officer Program Agreement as well as a breakdown of wage costs for the county set at 25% and school districts at 75%. Motion by Lorenzen seconded by Andreasen to fund current budget without amending the budget in the amount of \$32,776.51 with reimbursement from Ft Calhoun and Arlington School Districts in the amount of \$24,548.60. Vote- Aye: Lorenzen, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried. Mike Robinson, Sheriff, discussed approval for financing replacement jail transport vehicle and requested agenda item be tabled. Motion by Kruger seconded by Frahm to table discussion of financing replacement jail vehicle till next Board meeting. Vote-Aye: Lorenzen, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried.

There were no comments from the public.

Committee Reports: Kruger passed out summary report comparing this month's collections and expenditures against August of last year. Frahm and Anderson discussed possible vehicle to be equipped for Emergency Manager's use.

Chairman declared meeting to be recessed until 5:00 P.M.

At 5:00 P.M. the Chairman opened a Public Hearing on the Washington County 2018-2019 Budget. Co Clerk Merry Truhlsen was present. Kruger gave a brief summary of the 2018-2019 Budget and explained some of the reasons for increases and decreases. Kruger stated the County levy would be .390073. Board discussed increases in some office budgets. Kramer discussed items listed under Miscellaneous in the General Fund. Public Comments: David Hunt spoke. Scott VanderSchaaf spoke. Chairman closed public hearing. Sullivan read the resolution. Motion Kruger seconded by Andreasen to adopt Resolution 2018-12, adopting the 2018-2019 Washington County Budget. Vote- Aye: Lorenzen, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried.

WASHINGTON COUNTY RESOLUTION 2018-12 OF ADOPTION AND APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, a proposed County Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019, prepared by the Budget Making Authority, was transmitted to the County Board on the 11th day of September, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska as follows:

SECTION I. That the budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2018, to June 30, 2019, as categorically evidenced by the Budget Document be, and the same hereby is, adopted as the Budget for Washington County for said fiscal year.

SECTION 2. That the offices, departments, activities and institutions herein named are hereby authorized to expend the amounts herein appropriated to them during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019.

SECTION 3. That the income necessary to finance the appropriations made and expenditures authorized shall be provided out of the unencumbered cash balance in each fund, revenues other than taxation to be collected during the fiscal year in each fund, and tax levy requirements for each fund.
