The Washington County Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Nebraska, met in regular session at 3:08 p.m. on Tuesday, June 25, 2019 in the Supervisor's meeting room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgment of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman Dethlefs declared the meeting was in session and that the meeting is being recorded. Dethlefs made note that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the door and the west wall. Present: Chairman, Steve Dethlefs, County Board Members, Jordan Rishel, Lisa Kramer, Bob Frahm, Andy Andreasen, Jay Anderson, and Steve Kruger. Also present, Co Clk Barb Sullivan, Chief Deputy Kevin Willis, and Co Attorney Scott VanderSchaaf.

Motion Anderson second Andreasen to approve agenda for June 25, 2019. Vote- Aye: Rishel, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Kruger and seconded by Frahm that the rules be suspended and that the minutes of the June 11, 2019 meeting be approved but not read at this meeting for the reason that all board members were furnished a copy of said minutes prior to the meeting. Vote- Aye: Rishel, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried.

Claims were received and reviewed, following which it was moved by Kruger and second by Rishel that the following claims at the end of these minutes be allowed except for Prochaska claim for \$14,465.51 as Board would like a more detailed invoice, and Clerk ordered to issue warrants on the various funds for the same. Vote- Aye: Rishel, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Kruger and seconded by Frahm that the following correspondence be received and placed on file. 1. Lodging Tax Revenues for tax year 2018 totals were \$16,805.14 and Jan-April 2019 are currently at \$5,094.83. Vote- Aye: Rishel, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Bob Smith, Road Forman, gave a brief update to Road projects and stated that they had a meeting with FEMA last week regarding their Request for Public Assistance. Next, Smith opened the following bids for a new Semi-Truck Tractor: 1. Freightliner Truck Center of Omaha, \$110,811.00 for a 2019 available now. 2. RDO of Lincoln, \$117,590.70 for a 2019 available now, and \$104,815.38 for a 2019 available in October. Price quotes vary due to specs and/or model differences. Matt Cavanaugh, Weitz Construction, gave a brief update on Justice Center project.

Planning Commission voted 5-0 on motion to approve the rezone. Chairman opened public hearing. Sullivan went through request. Chairman closed public hearing. Motion Kruger second Anderson to approve Rezone request for property located in SE ¼ SE ¼ Section 26 Township 19 North-Range 10 East of the 6th PM. Vote-Aye: Rishel, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson, Kruger. Nay: None. Motion carried.
Joyce Sallach and Monica Mitchell request modification of a CUP to add 60 sites for an RV Park Complex in accordance with

CUP modification for up to 120 camper spots with services. None of the spots with services will have year round campers. At no time will there be more than 120 campers on site. The 20 primitive lots in Phase 1 are displacement lots only during the camping season and for storage in the off season. Chairman opened public hearing. Sullivan went through request. Monica Mitchell spoke and answered questions from Board. Chairman closed public hearing. VanderSchaaf provided a packet to Board members that outlined the need for services and projected costs savings. Board discussed options. Motion Kramer second Frahm to approve openings/contracts for Contract Public Defender, Contract Juvenile Public Defender and Contract Guardian Ad Litem positions/services including approval to advertise contract/positions and refer to Personnel Committee for recommendations including selection process, interviews and salary negotiations. Vote- Aye: Rishel, Kramer, Frahm, Dethlefs, Andreasen, Anderson. Nay: Kruger. Motion carried.

Kramer discussed contract for maintenance of township roads. Co Atty, VanderSchaaf, suggested the contract be revised to which Hwy Supt, Hansel, agreed. VanderSchaaf provided the Board with 3 contract versions: A, B, and C. Contract "A" is based on a NIRMA template, "B" makes changes to one of the paragraphs, and "C" eliminates same paragraph.
