

**January 13, 2020 Minutes

The Board of Supervisors Appointment Committee of Washington County, Nebraska, met in a special meeting at 3:00 p.m. on Monday, January 13, 2020 in the Multi-Purpose Meeting Room at the Courthouse in Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Pilot-Tribune. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgment of the receipt of notice and the agenda are on record at the office of the County Clerk.
